SINGAPORE - Information



Singapore has a tropical rainforest climate

◆ JANUARY TO MARCH

Average temperature between 25°C and 31°C . Heavy rainfall, especially in December and January, as this period falls within the Northeast Green season. Expect frequent afternoon thunderstorms.

◆ APRIL TO JUNE

Average temperature of 26°C to 32°C. Rainfall is generally moderate during this time. There are still occasional heavy showers, but overall it is drier compared to the green season.

◆ JULY TO SEPTEMBER

Average temperature between 26°C and 32°C. Drier conditions prevail during this period, though there are still occasional afternoon showers.

◆ OCTOBER TO DECEMBER

Average temperature between 25°C and 31°C. This marks the start of the Northeast Green season, with heavier rains returning in November and December. Expect more frequent afternoon and evening downpours.

Located around 20 km from downtown Singapore, it serves as a major hub for Southeast Asian and long-haul flights. With four terminals and a capacity of over 70 million passengers a year, it offers a unique experience with indoor gardens, relaxation areas, a free cinema and even a rooftop swimming pool. Its iconic **Jewel Changi** complex, with its spectacular indoor waterfall and numerous stores and restaurants, makes it much more than just an airport: it's a destination in itself.

Transport in Singapore is efficient, modern, and well-organized.

Here are the main means of transport:

- 🚇 **MRT (Mass Rapid Transit)** – The metro is the fastest and most convenient way to get around. It covers the whole city with well-connected lines.
- 🚌 **Bus** – An extensive, air-conditioned bus network serving even areas not accessible by MRT.
- 🚕 **Taxis** – Available everywhere, with affordable fares and the option of paying by card. Premium and electric cabs are also available.
- 📱 **VTC (Grab, Gojek, Ryde, TADA)** – Popular ride-sharing applications, often more affordable than traditional cabs.
- 🚲 **Self-service bicycles and scooters** – A number of applications allow you to rent a bike or scooter for short trips.
- 🚢 **Ferries and water taxis** – Ferry services are available to neighboring islands such as Pulau Ubin and Sentosa.
- 🚶 **By foot** – Singapore is a very safe city, with good pedestrian facilities, especially in the city center and tourist areas.

Singaporean gastronomy is a **unique blend of Chinese, Malay, Indian and Western influences**, reflecting the country's cultural diversity. It is renowned for its **hawker center**, food markets where you can find tasty dishes at affordable prices.

// **Signature Dishes:**

- **Hainanese Chicken Rice** – Poached chicken served with fragrant rice and a ginger-chili sauce.
- **Chili Crab** – Spicy crab in a sweet tomato and chilli sauce.
- **Laksa** – A spicy soup made with coconut milk, rice noodles and seafood.
- **Hokkien Mee** – Noodles sautéed with seafood in a rich broth.
- **Char Kway Teow** – Rice pasta sautéed with shrimp, egg and bean sprouts.
- **Satay** – Grilled meat skewers served with a peanut sauce.
