TAIWAN - Information



Taiwan has a varied climate due to its diverse geography, with distinct seasons.

◆ **SPRING** From March to May

The southwest monsoon starts in May and ends in late September. Heavy rainfall can occur any time of year, and the typhoon season generally runs from May into October.

◆ **SUMMER** From June to August

Hot and humid, with frequent thunderstorms and occasional typhoons.

◆ **AUTUMN** From September to November

Warm temperatures and low humidity, with clear skies and less rain.

◆ **WINTER** From December to February

Cooler, with temperatures dropping in the north, but generally mild in the south; occasional cold fronts bring rain and chilly weather.



Best time to travel: The best times to travel to Taiwan are spring (March to May) and autumn (September to November). During these seasons, the weather is mild and pleasant.
