

Main Spots to Visit in Taiwan

Alishan

Located in Chiayi County, Alishan is a scenic mountain area in central Taiwan known for its breathtaking sunrise views, the Alishan Railway, and ancient cedar trees. It offers a mix of hiking trails, beautiful landscapes, and tranquil retreats, making it a popular destination for nature lovers. The area also boasts a "sea of clouds" that visitors can enjoy during early mornings.

Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall
