RELIGIONS & SPIRITUALITY ESCAPEDE IN HANOI (VNEHAN-01)

4 days / 3 nights

A predominantly Buddhist country, Vietnam is at the crossroads of a multitude of influences, from Chinese and Khmer to Hindu, with the emergence of the Champa Kingdom. Later, French colonization brought with it Christianity. Today, Vietnam is a remarkable mosaic of religions that coexist peacefully. Our escapade opens the doors to the most beautiful temples, pagodas and churches, not forgetting those of tai chi and meditation, while enjoying vegetarian dishes!

OUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Discovery of the **Mausoleum of President Ho Chi Minh**, where the remains of the national hero and father of the nation are laid to rest.
- Excursion to **Hoa Lu**, the ancient capital of Vietnam in the 10th century.
- Visit several **pagodas** (Tran Quoc Pagoda, Bich Dong Pagoda...) and **cathedrals** (Phat Diem Cathedral, Saint Joseph Cathedral in Hanoi...).
- Visit the **Museum of Ethnology**, presenting a mosaic of Vietnam's 54 officially recognized ethnic groups.
- **Meeting and spiritual discovery with a monk** during a visit to a Buddhist sanctuary. Introduction to meditation, followed by a vegetarian lunch.



DID YOU KNOW?

With a population of around 100 million, Vietnam is home to **54 ethnic groups**: the Viet (Kinh) and 53 minority groups. The latter often include numerous local groups. The languages of Vietnam's ethnic groups are equally diverse, with **five language families**.





FLAVORS & SPICES ESCAPADE IN HANOI (VNEHAN-02)

4 days / 3 nights

This original discovery tour combines classic visits to Hanoi's most beautiful sites with an introduction to local flavors, including market visits, a cooking class and a tasting dinner. This escapade immerses you in the history of the country through its dishes.

OUR HIGHLIGHTS

- **Meet an expert of Vietnamese gastronomy** and sample local specialties such as “Bun Cha” (grilled meat served with rice noodles); “Pho Bo” (soup made from rice noodles, broth and a few aromatic herbs)...
- Stroll through a local market to select ingredients for a **chef-led cooking class**.
- **Tasting of Vietnamese fruits** according to season: cinnamon apple, milk apple, rambutan, mangosteen...
- **Scents and spices**, discover local scents through workshops.



DID YOU KNOW?

The pride of Vietnamese cuisine lies in its spices, which never cease to amaze and delight. Here are just a few of the most widely used: star anise, pepper, coriander seeds, ginger, lemongrass, cinnamon, cardamom, garlic...





ARTS & CRAFTS ESCAPE IN HANOI (VNEHAN-03)

4 days / 3 nights

This program is the perfect opportunity for art lovers to discover traditional Vietnamese music, local artists and unique handicraft techniques such as ceramics, painting... This getaway promises immersion in a rich and diverse cultural environment, offering an unforgettable experience.

OUR HIGHLIGHTS

- Exploration of the **36 Corporations Quarter**, a maze of alleyways that make up the capital's old city center and bring together dozens of traditional trades such as the manufacture and sale of votive papers, bamboo works, etc....
- Visit the **Museum of Fine Arts**, home to numerous treasures including collections of textiles, furniture, antiques, paintings and sculptures.
- Discover an **art gallery** featuring paintings and sculptures by **contemporary Vietnamese artists**.
- **Traditional water puppet show, song, and dance performance** in a community house.
- Visit the village of Bat Trang, where the **art of ceramics** has been perpetuated for generations, and the village of Dong Ho, which specializes in traditional painting. An opportunity to try your hands at this unique technique of **painting on paper**.





NATURE & WELLNESS ESCAPE IN HANOI (VNEHAN-04)

4 days / 3 nights

A few days of adventure in and around Hanoi (Cuc Phuong National Park). The trip also includes time for relaxation: massage, Tai Chi sessions and a meeting with a traditional doctor.

OUR HIGHLIGHTS

- **Traditional foot massage** to revitalize the body by stimulating certain points under the arch of the foot.
- **Private Tai Chi session** (ancestral art that balances internal energy while strengthening the body and its natural defenses).
- Visit an **herbalist's shop** with many examples of Vietnamese pharmacopoeia.
- **Meet a traditional doctor in his practice**, who will explain the fundamentals of Vietnamese medicine and perform a quick medical check-up for any visitors interested in their **internal Yin Yang balance**.
- Visit a **center for natural products** (cosmetics, home perfumes, etc.) which has drawn local resources to develop original, high-quality crafts.
- Exploration of **Cuc Phuong National Park**, hiking and cycling.
- Stroll through the **rice fields**.









WORLD HERITAGE SITES (VNTHEM-01)

10 days / 9 nights

This program is designed for enthusiasts of cultural and historical sites listed as World Heritage Sites by UNESCO. Discover Vietnam's cultural and natural treasures.

Day 1 HANOI

Welcome by our representative at the airport, transfer and check-in at the hotel.

Day 2 HANOI – NINH BINH – HANOI

Exploration of Hoa Lu, once the capital of Vietnam in the 10th century and the **Trang An landscape complex**. Boat trip and visit to natural caves. Meet villagers and artists before attending a water puppet show.

Day 3 HANOI – HALONG

Depart to **Halong Bay**, a UNESCO-listed site. Board a junk for an overnight stay. Culinary activity on board.

Day 4 HALONG – HANOI – NIGHT TRAIN

Morning sail and stopover to visit a natural cave. Return to Hanoi and visit the **imperial city of Thang Long** before taking the night train to Dong Hoi.

Day 5 NIGHT TRAIN – DONG HOI – PHONG NHA

Welcome by our representative at the station, transfer to the hotel and check-in. Day trip devoted exclusively to the **Phong Nha Caves**.

Day 6 DONG HOI – HUE

Drive to **Hue**, former capital of Vietnam under the Nguyen Dynasty. Discover the Imperial City. Visit to the **Thien Mu** (Heavenly Lady) Pagoda, one of the city's most venerated sites. Dinner in a restaurant accompanied by **Nha Nhac**, an ancient Vietnamese court music.

Day 7 HUE – DANANG – HOI AN

Visit the Emperors' Mausoleums, forming an immense park where nature is omnipresent. Stop at a workshop to discover the secrets of conical hat and incense stick making. Depart for Danang via the "Hai Van Pass". Then on to the **port city of Hoi An**.

Day 8 HOI AN

Discover the old town of Hoi An, and stroll through its narrow streets lined with traditional houses and its most symbolic monuments. Visit a lantern factory and introduction to this ancestral technique. Depart aboard a boat for a trip on the Thu Bon River, stopping off at traditional ceramics and carpentry villages.

Day 9 HOI AN – MY SON – HOI AN

Depart to **My Son**, remnant of the ancient kingdom of Champa. The archaeological site boasts some twenty monuments.

Day 10 HOI AN – DANANG - DEPART



We have not included the Hô Dynasty Citadel (a UNESCO World Heritage Site), as it takes around 2 extra days to get there. We can add this site to the program on request.

ESSENTIALS OF VIETNAM (VNTIMA)

8 days / 7 nights

This must-see tour allows you to discover the country’s treasures, with an initial immersion in the vibrant capital Hanoi, its rich cultural heritage and lively alleyways. Discover Halong Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage site, on a cruise. Explore the ancient city of Hoi An, the former imperial capital of Hue and the economic capital of Ho Chi Minh City. An itinerary that offers a rich and diverse overview of Vietnam’s culture, history and landscapes.

Welcome by our representative at the airport, transfer and check-in at the hotel.
- Day 2 HANOI**
Exploration of the Vietnamese capital (Temple of Literature, Museum of Ethnology, Mausoleum of President Ho Chi Minh...). Traditional water puppet show.

Depart to Hue, the ancient imperial city, via the Cloud Pass. Visit the Emperors’ tombs, the Imperial City and the Thien Mu (Heavenly Lady) Pagoda.
- Day 6 HUE – HO CHI MINH CITY**
Transfer to Hue airport for the flight to Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon). Discover the country’s economic capital (City Hall, Opera House, Independence Palace...).
- Day 7 HO CHI MINH CITY – BEN TRE – HO CHI MINH CITY**
Excursion to Ben Tre Province. Visit a rice paper manufacturing workshop, a brick factory before boarding a local boat to sail down the Mekong.
- Day 8 HO CHI MINH CITY - DEPART**

An In-depth immersion from the capital. From Tonkin to the Mekong Delta via the Mandarin route, this program offers a classic discovery tour of the very essence of Vietnam. With its impressive landscapes and tasty cuisine, this must-do tour offers a first taste of the country.

Day 1 HANOI

Welcome by our representative at the airport, transfer and check-in at the hotel.

Day 2 HANOI

Visit the emperors' mausoleums. Stop at a workshop to discover the secrets of conical hat and incense stick making, then depart for Danang (visit the Cham archaeological museum). The road continues to Hoi An.

Day 8 HOI AN

Discover the old town of Hoi An. Stroll along the Thu Bon River, stopping off at traditional ceramics and carpentry villages.

Day 9 HOI AN – DANANG – HO CHI MINH CITY

Transfer to Danang airport for the flight to Ho Chi Minh City. Exploration of the country's economic capital (City Hall, Opera House, Independence Palace...).

Day 10 HO CHI MINH CITY – CAI BE – VINH LONG – CAN THO

Depart to Cai Be, in the heart of the Mekong Delta. Embark for a cruise, visit an old colonial house and an artisanal puffed rice factory.

Day 11 CAN THO – MY THO – HO CHI MINH CITY

Depart to the small market on the water at Cai Rang. Visit the century-old house of Binh Thuy and discover the market halls of Can Tho, before heading back to Ho Chi Minh City.

Day 12 HO CHI MINH CITY – DEPART

15 days / 14 nights



A multi-day adventure to discover Vietnam, its people and its fantastic landscapes... A veritable jewel of culture and history! Discover the minority villages and rice paddies in the Northwest, stroll through the lively streets of the capital Hanoi, cruise Halong Bay, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and immerse yourself in the Mekong Delta. With its impressive landscapes, tasty cuisine and warm welcome, Vietnam offers a memorable experience.



Day 1 HANOI

Welcome by our representative at the airport, transfer and check-in at the hotel. Traditional water puppet show.

Day 2 HANOI – HOA LU – HANOI – NIGHT TRAIN

Depart to Hoa Lu, once the capital of Vietnam in the 10th century. Cycle and sampan ride. Transfer to the station for the night train to Lao Cai.

Day 3 NIGHT TRAIN – LAO CAI – SAPA

Arrival in Lao Cai, depart to one of the region's many mountain markets. Drive to Sapa and check-in at the hotel.

Day 4 SAPA

A day dedicated to discovering the region's minority villages. Encounter with several ethnic groups (Black H'Mongs, Giay, Red Dao...). Hike to the bamboo forest of Giang Ta Chai.

Day 5 SAPA – LAO CAI – NIGHT TRAIN

Visit to the village of Cat Cat. Excursion to the Thac Tinh Yeu Waterfalls, followed by a stop at the Tram Ton Pass. Transfer to Lao Cai station for the night train to Hanoi.

Day 6 NIGHT TRAIN – HANOI – HALONG

Board a junk for a cruise on Halong Bay, a UNESCO-listed site. Culinary activity on board.

Day 7 HALONG – HANOI – HUE

Morning sail to visit a natural cave, then return to Hanoi. Transfer to the airport for the flight to Hue.

Day 8 HUE

Explore Hue, discovering the Imperial City, the Thien Mu Pagoda and the tombs of the emperors: Emperor Minh Mang and Emperor Tu Duc, the 4th emperor of the Nguyen Dynasty who reigned from 1847 to 1883. Stop at a family workshop specializing in the manufacture of conical hats and incense sticks.

Day 9 HUE – DANANG – HOI AN

Depart to Danang via the "Hai Van Pass" (visit the Cham archaeological museum). The road continues to Hoi An.

Day 10 HOI AN

Discover the old town. Visit to a lantern factory and introduction to this ancestral technique. Stroll along the Thu Bon River, stopping off at traditional ceramics and carpentry villages.

Day 11 HOI AN – DANANG – HO CHI MINH CITY

Transfer to Danang airport for the flight to Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon). Discovery of the country's economic capital (City Hall, Opera House, Independence Palace...).

Day 12 HO CHI MINH CITY – CAI BE – VINH LONG – CAN THO

Depart to Cai Be, in the heart of the Mekong Delta. Embark for a cruise, visit an old colonial house and an artisanal puffed rice factory.

Day 13 CAN THO – CAI RANG – CHAU DOC

Excursion by sampan to the small market on the water at Cai Rang. Stroll through Can Tho Market, then transfer to Chau Doc, on the border with Cambodia. Walk to Mount Nui Sam (284m), a Buddhist pilgrimage site dotted with dozens of temples and pagodas combining Chinese, Cham and Khmer influences.

Day 14 CHAU DOC – HO CHI MINH CITY

Boat trip to discover the floating fish farms. Stop in a Cham village and visit its mosque. Return to Ho Chi Minh City by road.

Day 15 HO CHI MINH CITY – DEPART



THE GRAND TOUR OF VIETNAM (VNTGTO)

21 days / 20 nights

From north to south, discover the ethnic minorities of the north, followed by the famous Halong Bay, the Central Highlands and the Mekong Delta. With its impressive landscapes, tasty cuisine and warm welcome, Vietnam offers a memorable experience.



Day 1 HANOI

Welcome by our representative at the airport, transfer and check-in at the hotel.

Day 2 HANOI

Exploration of the Vietnamese capital (Temple of Literature, Museum of Ethnology, Mausoleum of President Ho Chi Minh...). Traditional water puppet show.

Day 3 HANOI – MASTER PAGODA – KY SON

Head to the nearby village of Son Dong, specialized in furniture-making and woodcarving, and visit the Thay Pagoda (Pagoda of the Master). Continue to the small village of Ky Son.

Day 4 KY SON – DUONG LAM – HANOI – NIGHT TRAIN

Discover the villages of Duong Lam and Van Phuc, the latter specialized in the production of natural silk. Return to Hanoi and transfer to the station for the night train to Lao Cai.

Day 5 NIGHT TRAIN – LAO CAI – SAPA

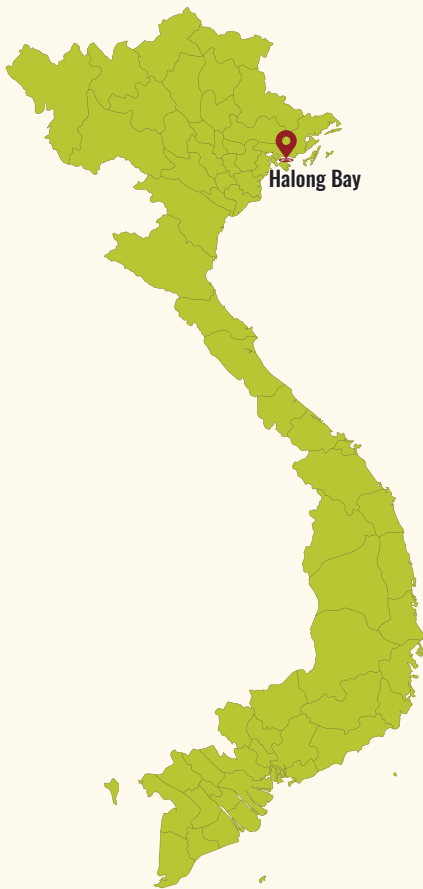
Visit one of the region's many mountain markets. Drive to Sapa and check-in at the hotel. Sapa is home to over 30 ethnic minorities and Vietnam's highest peak, Mount Fansipan.





- Day 6 SAPA**
A day dedicated to discovering the minority villages of the Sapa region (Black H'Mongs, Giay, Red Dao...). Hike to the bamboo forest of Giang Ta Chai.
- Day 7 SAPA – LAO CAI – NIGHT TRAIN**
Visit the village of Cat Cat. Excursion to the Thac Tinh Yeu Waterfalls, followed by a stop at the Tram Ton Pass. Transfer to Lao Cai station for the night train to Hanoi.
- Day 8 NIGHT TRAIN – HANOI – HALONG**
Board a junk for a cruise on Halong Bay, a UNESCO-listed site. Culinary activity on board.
- Day 9 HALONG**
Second day of cruising. Board a boat and continue the excursions as the junk resumes its journey.
- Day 10 HALONG – HANOI – HUE**
The junk sails across the bay, stopping to visit a natural cave. Transfer by road to Hanoi airport for the flight to Hue.
- Day 11 HUE**
Explore Hue, discovering the Imperial City, the Thien Mu Pagoda and the tombs of the emperors: Emperor Minh Mang and Emperor Tu Duc, the 4th emperor of the Nguyen Dynasty who reigned from 1847 to 1883. Stop at a family workshop specializing in the manufacture of conical hats and incense sticks.
- Day 12 HUE – DANANG – HOI AN**
Depart to Danang via the “Hai Van Pass” (visit the Cham archaeological museum). The road continues to Hoi An.
- Day 13 HOI AN**
Discover the old town. Visit a lantern factory and introduction to this ancestral technique. Stroll along Thu Bon River, stopping off at traditional ceramics and carpentry villages.

Depart to Kontum in the Highlands. Stop at several communal houses belonging to different ethnic groups and meet the “H’re”, the last tribe in the region.
- Day 15 KONTUM**
Visit the Kontum’s seminary and the wooden church, built in 1913. Walk to the Banhar villages of Kontum Konam, Konko Wang, Kon Jari and Kon Kotu.
- Day 16 KONTUM – BUON MA THUOT**
Depart to Buon Ma Thuot, through numerous pepper and coffee plantations.
- Day 17 BUON MA THUOT – LAK LAKE – BUON MA THUOT**
Visit the Buon Ma Thuot Ethnological Museum. Depart by road to Lak Lake, located in the heart of a volcanic region. On arrival, meeting with the elephants. Enjoy a Gong show and rice alcohol tasting with the M’ngong people.
- Day 18 BUON MA THUOT – HO CHI MINH CITY**
Excursion to the village of Akodhong, inhabited by the Ede ethnic group. This village is renowned for its longhouses and coffee plantations. Stop at Drei Nur Falls. Depart to Ho Chi Minh City.
- Day 19 HO CHI MINH CITY**
Discovery of Ho Chi Minh City (Saigon), the country’s economic capital (City Hall, Opera House, Independence Palace...).
- Day 20 HO CHI MINH CITY – BEN TRE – HO CHI MINH CITY**
Day trip to Ben Tre Province, in the Mekong delta.
- Day 21 HO CHI MINH CITY – DEPART**
